

Online Safe Spaces Quarterly Report January – March 2021

Online Safe Spaces is a portal that is accessible via a widget from a customer facing website or an employee intranet page. Online Safe Spaces is a free, open-source tool that is available to businesses and organisations across the UK.

By clicking the Safe Spaces widget, you will access the Online Safe Space, which holds a directory of national domestic abuse helplines, a GPS directory of local specialist domestic abuse services and assessment questionnaire. The site is available in multiple languages and has a quick exit button, taking the user back to original business page which provides a degree of safety to the user.

Online Safe Spaces Project Aim

- Be live on 10 websites in 12 months.
- Increase opportunity for victims of domestic abuse to access specialist support, safely.

To date, 26 businesses and organisations have adopted Online Safe Spaces, which we estimate has now received over 200,000 visits in the past 6 months.

Online Safe Spaces primary functions:

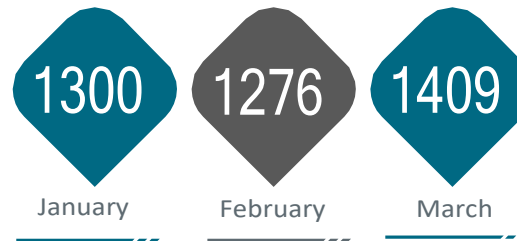
- All four nations' helpline information.
